



# Adding printers to Mac

- System Preferences > Printers & Scanners
  - If there are printers already listed, you'll have to delete them (click and hit the minus symbol)




- Click the “+” symbol > Click on the “IP” Icon (the globe symbol)



- Add the IP address of the printer you want to connect to in the “Address” bar. The IP address can be found by looking at the label on the actual physical printer itself.

- Go to the “Protocol” drop down menu. Select “HP Jetdirect – Socket” driver. This also works for the Xerox printer/copier. (The Kyocera printers should automatically detect the driver after it has been installed on the Mac)



- Feel free to change the name to reflect the corresponding printer you are connecting to. (The Printer's name is also on a label attached to the actual physical printer itself)
